**SUPPLEMENTARY JUDGMENT OF CHIEF JUDGE GL COLGAN**

[1]     The Court of Appeal, in its judgment in *Parker v Silver Fern Farms Limited and the Employment Court*,<sup>1</sup> remitted to this Court the question of what was to become of the Court's interim order prohibiting publication of the name of, or otherwise identifying, the plaintiff's counsel.

[2]     The lawyer, Mr Alan Cressey, who sought the order for non-publication, now consents to its discharge and, through counsel Mr BA Corkill QC, does not apply for a permanent order.
