**CONSENT INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT OF JUDGE KATHRYN BECK
(Application for stay of proceedings)**

[1] On 23 March 2022 the Employment Relations Authority made a declaration sought by the New Zealand Nurses Organisation.¹

[2] Arohanui Hospice Service Trust has challenged that determination.

[3] The parties have asked the Court to make an order staying execution of the Authority's determination pending the outcome of the challenge.
