**INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT (NO 4)
OF CHIEF JUDGE CHRISTINA INGLIS
(Application for continuation of freezing order)
(Application to vary freezing order)**

[1] On 14 April 2022 I granted an application for freezing and ancillary orders against Mr Munro, a former employee of Solander Maritime Ltd.¹ Subsequent applications to continue the freezing order were granted on 29 April 2022², 25 May

2022³ and 29 June 2022.⁴ The freezing order was to have effect until 29 July 2022, unless on or before that date it was continued or renewed.

[2] The parties have filed a joint memorandum seeking a continuation and variation (in terms of clause 4 of the joint memorandum) of the freezing order to 5 August 2022 to enable matters to be resolved on agreed terms. In the circumstances I am satisfied that it is appropriate to grant the variation and extension sought. I record that the respondent's wife, who is a co-owner of a property subject to the freezing order, also consents to both the continuation and variation of the freezing order.

[3] By consent, I continue the current freezing order to **5.00 pm 5 August 2022**.
