COSTS JUDGMENT OF JUDGE K G SMITH (An application for costs on stay proceedings)

[1] On 6 June 2023, I dismissed applications by Carrington Resort Jade LP for a stay of proceedings. The judgment determined Ms Knight's entitlement to costs and the parties were invited to agree about them. If they could not agree, memoranda were invited.¹

[2] The parties did not agree. On 15 June 2023 Mr Mark, counsel for Ms Knight,

filed a brief memorandum seeking costs.

[3] A timetable had not been directed for an exchange of submissions. Given

Mr Mark's succinct submissions, encompassing one page, a minute was issued

providing an opportunity for Carrington to respond within a reasonably short

timeframe. The minute was issued on 15 June 2023 and Carrington was provided with

an opportunity to reply no later than 29 June 2023. Carrington has not provided any

submissions.

[4] Ms Knight sought a costs order of \$3,824. That amount was based on applying

category 2, band B to each of the steps taken, namely for filing a notice of opposition

and preparing Ms Knight's submissions.²

[5] I am satisfied that category 2B is appropriate and that the steps taken by Ms

Knight were reasonable.

Conclusion

[6] Carrington is ordered to pay Ms Knight costs of \$3,824.
