JUDGMENT (NO 2) OF JUDGE B A CORKILL

- [1] Yesterday, I issued a judgment granting a search order, which included the authorisation of certain redactions to one of two affidavits which had been filed, that of Mr Lance Davis.
- [2] Today, Ms Amaranathan, counsel for the applicant, has sought further redactions to the second affidavit, that of Ms Jaqueline Edwards. The proposed further redactions relate to annexures containing a customer list and sales information, including customer names, as well as references to Mr Nikorima's sales figures and revenue within the body of that affidavit.

[3] Given the circumstances I reviewed in my first judgment, it is appropriate to extend the redactions direction as sought.²

[4] An amended draft order has also been filed incorporating the proposed further

redaction, which I approve.

served. For the avoidance of doubt, these include the two judgments of this Court, the

draft statement of problem, the affidavits (but with the redactions proposed), the

application for an order, all of counsel's memoranda, and the undertakings, together

with the approved search order.

[6] This judgment is not to be published other than to the parties, their

representatives, and to the authorised persons who are to execute the search order, until

further direction from the Court.
