CONSENT COSTS JUDGMENT OF CHIEF JUDGE CHRISTINA INGLIS

[1] Danske Mobler Ltd applied for special leave to remove an objection to an improvement notice from the Employment Relations Authority to the Court for hearing and determination pursuant to s 178 of the Employment Relations Act 2000. Special leave was required because the Authority had previously declined to remove

the matter.¹ The Court granted special leave on 19 December 2023.² Costs on the application were reserved.

[2] By joint memorandum dated 8 February 2024 the parties have advised they have reached agreement on the issue of costs and requested orders by consent in the following terms:

- (a) that costs should lie where they fall in relation to the application for special leave;
- (b) that the costs determination of the Employment Relations Authority dated 3 March 2023 be quashed;³ and
- (c) that the costs and disbursements in the Authority proceeding lie where they fall.

[3] Having reviewed the orders sought, I am satisfied that it is appropriate to make them, and accordingly do so.
